In my composter (brown bin)

Table leftovers, plants, fibers

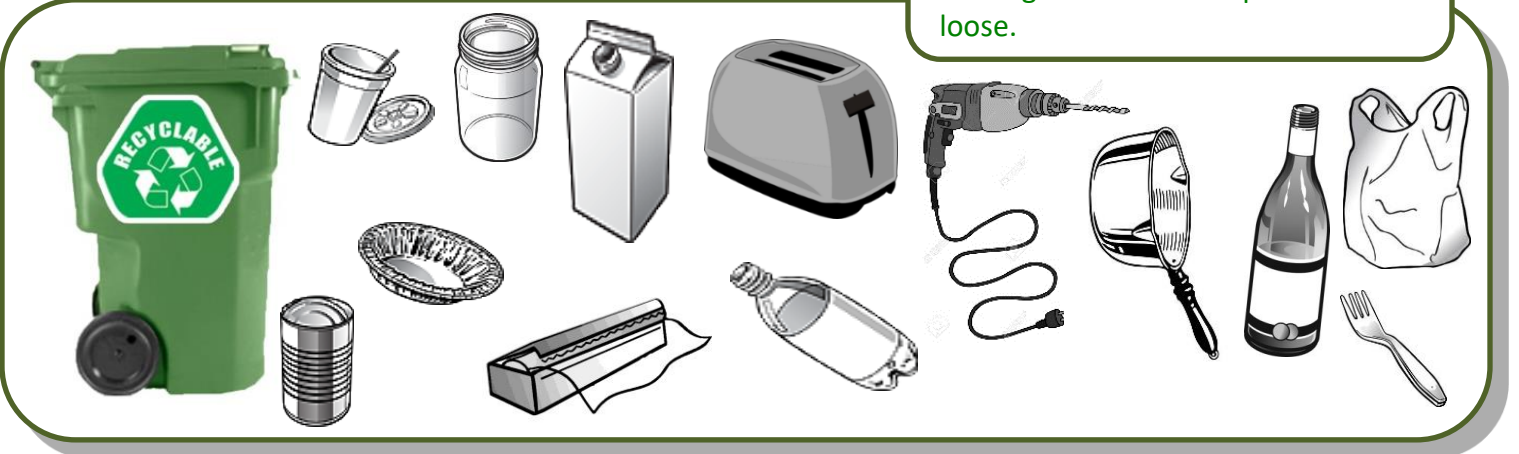


IMPORTANT!

It is recommended to drop materials loose in the bin or to use paper bags.

In my recycling bin (green bin)

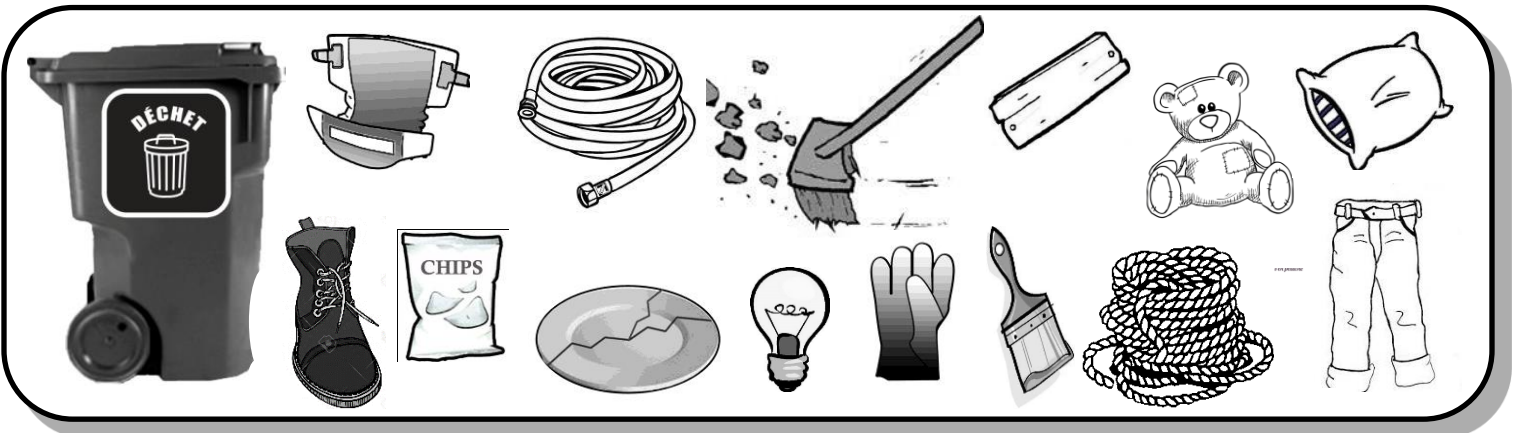
Glass, metals, plastics (hard and soft) and
Tetra Pak containers (juice, milk)



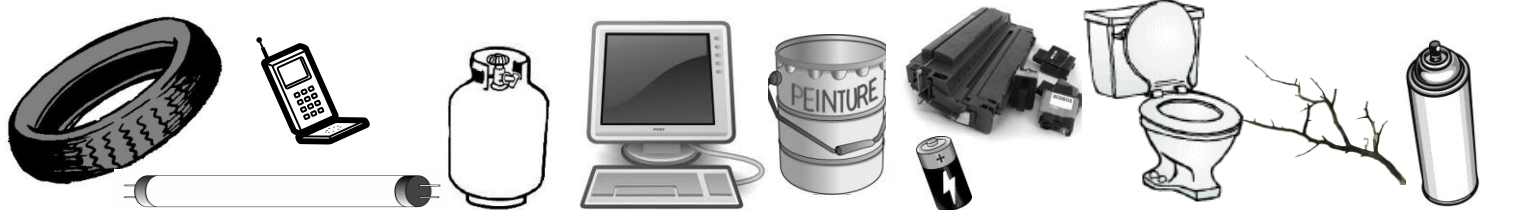
It is recommended to lightly rinse these materials before putting them in the green bin and to place them in loose.

In my garbage bin (black bin)

Non-recyclable materials, broken window, dishes, and other waste



At the transfer site and other places for that purpose.



Before bringing those materials or other products that cannot be put in the rolling bins, it is preferable **to check first with the Waste Management Center** by dialing 418 986-3100, extension 192.

GREAT HABITS TO KEEP

- ✓ Avoid buying highly wrapped products
- ✓ Buy durable and reusable products rather than disposable or inferior quality ones
- ✓ Buy products in bulk as much as possible
- ✓ Bring your reusable grocery bags to reduce the use of plastic bags
