



CRITERIA TO BECOME A FIREFIGHTER



A volunteer firefighter will have the responsibility to fight fires, use the jaws-of-life when needed in car accidents and intervene during any kind of disasters on the territory of Îles-de-la-Madeleine.

REQUIREMENTS TO BECOME A VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTER

- ✓ To reside in the community of Îles-de-la-Madeleine.
- ✓ Be at least 18 years old.
- ✓ A priority will be given to the holder of a high school diploma or equivalent recognized by the minister of Education.
- ✓ To hold a driver's license class 4A or commit to get it within six months following his/her recruitment.
- ✓ A verification of the legal backgrounds and any criminal activity will be carried out.
- ✓ Be in a good physical condition.
- ✓ On demand to present a medical certificate.
- ✓ Pass the assessment physical exam.
- ✓ Commit to the training program POMPIER 1 and finish it within the allotted time fixed by the Municipality.
