



Criteria to become a firefighter

A volunteer firefighter will have the responsibility to fight fires, use the jaws-of-life when needed in car accidents and intervene during any kind of disasters on the territory of Îles-de-la-Madeleine.

Requirements to become a volunteer firefighter

- Reside in Îles-de-la-Madeleine and in close proximity to a fire station;
- Hold a driver's license class 4A or commit to get it within six months following recruitment;
- Hold or agree to take the Firefighter 1 training program (260 hours);
- Hold a Secondary 5 diploma or equivalent;
- Be in good physical condition (pre-employment physical evaluation test);
- No medical contraindication to firefighting;
- No criminal record incompatible with the performance of duties;
- Demonstrate a high level of availability and the ability to intervene in emergency situations and perform tasks with precision and diligence.
